

SERGER FLATLOCK PLACEMAT CLASS

Level: Advanced Beginner (Must have working knowledge of serger)

Do a quick-change with your table décor by creating colorful, reversible placemats that are made by using the “wrong sides together” flatlock technique on your serger. Make the best use of your time by choosing your preference of three options for finishing the edges (serge and turn, binding, or flatlock edge).

Add a designer finish to any table setting with reversible napkins and coordinating napkin rings. Your serger makes it possible to have a custom table setting with ease and simplicity.

This is a Martha Pullen project class. The pattern is exclusive to licensed Martha Pullen teachers. Martha Pullen written instructions with diagrams are provided in class.

Supply List:

- **Serger** in good working order and knowledge of the machine (how to thread), power cord, foot controller, manual and serger accessories (spool pin/cap for decorative thread if not cone, tweezers, brush).
- **Fabric for 2 Placemats:**
 - ¼ yard Fabric A for center
 - ¼ yard Fabric B for center
 - ¼ yard Fabric C for center
 - ½ yard Fabric D for center and borders. Fabric D is in the middle of placemat and the borders.
 - ½ yard Fabric E for backing
 - ½ yard of thin 100% cotton batting
 - Optional: ¼ yard for binding
- **Fabric for 2 Napkins and Napkin Rings:**
 - 5/8-yard Fabric A
 - 5/8-yard Fabric B
 - ½ yard of ½ inch elastic

Bring extra fabric for testing stitches.

- 1 spool decorative heavy cotton or poly thread (30wt or 12wt solid, Sulky Blendable, WonderFil SoftLoc) or embroidery thread. Keep away from wooly nylon because it can melt with heat.
- 3 cones or spools of regular serging thread that coordinate with your fabric.
- #90/14 serger needles (consult your serger manual)
- Wash-away fabric marker or chalk
- Optional: fusible thread (for binding), steam-a-seam-2, stitch witchery or wonder tape.
- Basic Sewing supplies: Pins/Clips, scissors, tape measure, seam/sewing gauge, marking pen or chalk, seam ripper, hand sewing needle, point turner/chopstick, etc.
- Rotary cutter, mat, quilting ruler
