

Serger Gift Projects Class

Skill Level: Serger Beginner

Must have working knowledge of your serger and be able to thread serger.

Make quick and easy holiday/birthday/just for me gifts with your serger!

Instructions provided to make the following projects:

Small pouch, sunglass case, card holder, pocket tissue cover, coaster, QAYG (quilt as you go) mat, drawstring gift bag, and drawstring shoe bag with vinyl insert.

Most projects lined with no exposed seams, except bags.

Supply List:

- **Serger** in good **working** order, power cord, foot pedal, Manual and Serger accessories (tweezers, screwdriver, brush).
- Two new serger needles (90/14) -refer to your manual (bring extra needles in case of breakage)
- **Basic Sewing/Serger supplies:** Clips, pins, scissors (for cutting and trimming fabric), tape measure, seam/sewing gauge, marking pen or chalk, seam ripper, bodkin (or safety pin), etc.
- Iron and ironing surface
- Rotary cutter, ruler, cutting mat (if you want your own) – mats available to share in the classroom
- 4 regular spools/serger cone thread
- 1-2 yards cotton fabric

Project Supply List:

Small Pouch:

- 4.5" x 14" of cotton fabric

Sunglass Case:

- 8" x 8" Fabric A for outside of case
- 8" x 8" Fabric B for lining of case
- 7.5" x 7.5" low-loft cotton batting or fusible fleece

Card Holder:

- (2) 5" x 6" Fabric A for outside and inside
- (2) 5" x 5" Fabric B for pockets
- (1) 5" x 6" woven fusible interfacing for back of outside piece (like SF101) and fuse to one 5"x6" Fabric A piece. Can also use fusible fleece.

Pocket Tissue Cover:

- (2) 4.5" x 6" Fabric A for flaps
- (2) 4" x 6" Fabric B for back and inside

Coaster:

- (6) 5" x 5" of cotton fabric (can be same color or different colors from charm pack)

QAYG (Quilt As You Go) Mat:

- (5) 2.5" x 10" strips of cotton fabric for top (2 or more different colors)
- (5) 2.5" x 10" strips of cotton fabric for back
- (5) 2.5" x 10" strips of low-loft cotton batting

Gift Bag:

- (1) 9-1/2" x 20" Fabric A for main bag

- (2) 2-1/4" x 8-1/2" Fabric B for casing
- (1) 8" x 18-1/2" Fabric C for band
- 2 yards of 1/4" – 1/2" cording/ribbon for drawstring

Shoe Bag:

- (1) 12" x 8" Fabric A (non-directional) for front top
- (1) 12" x 18" Fabric B (non-directional) for front bottom/back
- (2) 12" x 3" Fabric C (non-directional) for top casing
- (1) 12" x 5-1/2" of Vinyl (will be supplied in class or you can bring your own)
- 2 yards of 1/4" – 1/2" cording/ribbon for drawstring

Preparation Before Class:

- Please make sure your serger works. Look in your manual to see how to change your needles and that you can untighten and tighten. If new or serviced machine, the screws may be hard to loosen.
- Set up your serger for a balanced 4-thread overlock stitch.

Class Cancellation Policy

To reserve a seat, all Pocono Sew & Vac classes must be paid in full upon registration.
