

Strip N Serge Top Class

The Strip N Serge Top Pattern by Patty Dunn uses strips of fabric serged together using the 2 or 3 thread Flatlock stitch (using ladder side or looper side). There are two neckline options: V-neckline and Boat neckline.

This class is for people that have a working knowledge of their serger.

Pre-Class cutting is required. Download and print the pattern/instructions before class.

Instructions include pattern templates for neck and sides. This is not a full-size pattern. There are also free instructions and template to convert from V Neckline to Boat Neckline.

Supply List:

- Serger in good working order, power cord, foot pedal, Manual and Serger accessories (tweezers, screwdriver, brush)
- **Fabric:** 1.25 yards each of 2 or more blending fabrics or 2.5 yards of one fabric.
 - **Recommended Fabric:** Rayon, Rayon Batik, polyester blend, light weight cotton, linen or linen/rayon blend.
 - Pre-Wash fabric before cutting.
 - Cut strips of fabric according to pattern instructions.
 - Bring left over fabric to class for sample test stitching.
- 2-3 spools/cone thread –
 - **Optional:** 1-2 spools of 12wt, 30wt thread or decorative thread like WonderFil SoftLoc, Sulky Blendable, etc. (The lower the number, the thicker the thread)
- New serger needles (75/11, 80/12 and/or 90/14 topstitch (if using 12wt in needle))- refer to your manual
- **Basic Sewing/Serger supplies:** Clips, pins, scissors (for cutting and trimming fabric), rotary cutter/mat/ruler, tape measure, seam/sewing gauge, marking pen or chalk, seam ripper, etc.
- Note pad and pen or pencil.

Preparation Before Class:

- Please make sure your serger works. Look in your manual to see how to change your needles and that you can untighten and tighten. If new or serviced machine, the screws may be hard to loosen.

- Pre-wash fabric and cut strips of fabric according to pattern instructions.

Class Cancellation Policy
