



# Magnetic Embroidery Hoop

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## Information

### Scope of Delivery

- 1x Embroidery Hoop
- 1x Separating Layer
- 1x Embroidery Template

### Purpose

Large Magnetic Embroidery Hoop:

- To embroider and quilt in the hoop.
- Max. embroidery area: 8.25 x 15.75" (210 x 400 mm)

Medium Border Magnetic Embroidery Hoop:

- To embroider and quilt in the hoop.
- Max. embroidery area: 6.25 x 15.75" (165 x 400 mm)

Medium Magnetic Embroidery Hoop:

- To embroider and quilt in the hoop.
- Max. embroidery area: 6.5 x 10.4" (165 x 265 mm)

### For Your Safety

Before using this accessory, please read this instruction manual as well as the instruction manual of your machine carefully.

### Malfunction of Medically Necessary Equipment

Cardiac pacemakers or other medical devices can be significantly interfered with in their function by the magnetic field of the embroidery hoop.

### Damage to Magnetic Storage Media, Electronic and Mechanical Devices

Magnetic media and devices can be permanently damaged in their function by the magnetic field of the embroidery hoop.

### How to Store/Transport the Magnetic Embroidery Hoop

Do not place or store the components of the hoop on top of each other without using an intermediate layer (the supplied separating material or fabric). Separating the components of the hoop that lie directly on top of each other can require a significant amount of force. Keep the Magnetic Embroidery Hoop out of the reach of children.

## Application

### Hooping the fabric

- > Place the fabric to be embroidered flat on the lower hoop.
- > Align the upper hoop with the coupling. **CAUTION! To avoid pinching your fingers between the two hoops, hold the upper hoop at a corner recess.**
- > Carefully fold the upper hoop down onto the fabric. (Fig. 3)
  - Both hoop components are flush on top of each other.
- > Pull the fabric evenly taut in the embroidery hoop.

### Attaching the hoop

- > Attach the hoop. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine. (Fig. 4)
- > Make sure that there is no fabric under the embroidery hoop.
- > Make sure that no additional fabric gets into the embroidery area while embroidering. With large fabrics, the right edge of the fabric should be rolled up and fixed.
- > Make sure that the upper hoop is flush with the lower hoop. Readjust if necessary.
- > Before using the hoop for the first time or if the needle position and the center of the hoop do not match, calibrate the hoop in the machine settings. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
- > Select the embroidery hoop on the machine.
  - Large Magnetic Embroidery Hoop: Mag-L
  - Medium Border Magnetic Embroidery Hoop: Mag-MB
  - Medium Magnetic Embroidery Hoop: Mag-M
- > Open an embroidery design on the machine and make the desired amendments. **Note:** Applications with CrystalWork are not suitable for this embroidery hoop.

### Rehooping the fabric

- > Remove the embroidery hoop. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
- > Lift the upper hoop at a corner recess to remove it from the lower hoop.
- > Reposition the fabric and fix it with the upper hoop.
- > Attach the hoop.

### Removing the Embroidery Hoop

- > Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
