



Sticky Embroidery Hoop

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Information

Scope of Delivery

- 1x Embroidery Hoop
- 1x Embroidery Template
- 10x Pre-cut Adhesive Stabilizer

Purpose

Medium Sticky Embroidery Hoop:

- To embroider fabrics and projects that cannot be hooped.
- To embroider close along the fabric edge.
- Max. Embroidery Area: 6.5 x 10.4" (165 x 265 mm)

Large Sticky Embroidery Hoop:

- To embroider fabrics and projects that cannot be hooped.
- To embroider close along the fabric edge.
- Max. Embroidery Area: 8.25 x 15.75" (210 x 400 mm)

For Your Safety

Before using this accessory, please read this instruction manual as well as the instruction manual of your machine carefully.

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Application

Attaching the Hoop

- ✓ The embroidery hoop is calibrated. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
- ✓ An embroidery design has been loaded and customized. **Note:** Applications with CrystalWork are not suitable for this embroidery hoop.
- ✓ The needle is positioned in the center of the embroidery design.
- ✓ The function "Stitch Out" has been activated.
- > Stick the adhesive stabilizer to the back of the embroidery hoop. Please refer to the tip. (Fig. 2)
- > Attach the hoop. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
- > Select the embroidery hoop on the machine.
 - Large Sticky Embroidery Hoop: Mag-L
 - Medium Sticky Embroidery Hoop: Mag-M

Tip: BERNINA recommends using tear-away stabilizer for woven fabrics and cut-away stabilizer for knitted fabrics.

When it comes to sticking the adhesive stabilizer in place, BERNINA recommends the following procedure:

- > Peel the protective film completely off the adhesive stabilizer and position it at the edge of the table.
- > Place the embroidery hoop with the top side facing down on the protective film so that the hoop coupling protrudes over the edge of the table. (Fig. 2)
- > Stick the adhesive stabilizer to the bottom side of the hoop and press it on.
- > Remove the protective film before attaching the embroidery hoop.

Hooing the Fabric

- > Position the project to be embroidered under the needle on the adhesive stabilizer.
- > Smooth the area to be embroidered out evenly and press it on.
- > To prevent the project from shifting, use the «Baste along the Embroidery Design» function. While doing so, sew at the slowest speed.
- > Make sure that no additional fabric gets into the embroidery area while embroidering. (Fig. 3)

Removing the Embroidery Hoop

- > Remove the embroidery hoop. Refer to the instruction manual of the machine.
- > To prevent the adhesive stabilizer from getting dirty, cover the adhesive surface of the embroidery stabilizer with the removed protective film until you are ready to use it again.
- > Once the embroidery stabilizer has been removed, clean any adhesive residue from the embroidery hoop.
