Candlewicking Foot

Instructions

The Candlewicking Foot has a deep tunnel on the underside of the foot to aid the foot in feeding over a build-up of thread when using a candlewicking, decorative or utility stitch that repeats over itself or has high density.

- 1. Select a decorative stitch.
- **Note:** While all decorative stitches can be used with this foot, some Baby Lock machine models have special candlewicking stitches. Examples of these type of stitches are shown below.
- 2. Attach the Candlewicking Foot.
- 3. Place the fabric under the presser foot, pull the upper thread out to the side and then lower the presser foot.
- 4. Sew at a smooth and consistent speed.
